NEAT AND TIDY DRESS CODE

In the effort to improve the image of 5 pin bowling, all participants in Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers Association events will be asked to adhere to the following Neat and Tidy Dress Code regulations:

Attire, accessories and footwear with designs/logos including derogatory or offensive phrases will not be allowed.

SHIRTS AND/OR SWEATERS:

- Must have sleeves and a finished neckline.
- Tank tops are not appropriate; however, T-shirts are.

PANTS, DRESS SHORTS, SKIRTS, SKORTS, CAPRIS, JOGGERS, LEGGINGS

- Must have straight hemmed bottom.
- No fluorescent colors, stirrups, spandex, harem, ruggers, cargo pants, denim with rips and/or tears, or sweatpants of any kind.
- Must be of a length that covers at least $\frac{3}{4}$ (three quarters) of the thigh.

BALL CAPS

- At all times, ball caps must be worn in the forward position.
- Although personal ball caps are allowed at Calgary 5 Pin events, only the approved Calgary Zone Ball Cap is allowed at Alberta 5 Pin Provincial Events.
- Note: Hats are not allowed at Canadian 5 Pin events unless worn for religious or medical reasons.

Bowlers disregarding the dress code will be asked to change or be subject to a fine.
