

2026 CALGARY ZONE

DUO SHOWDOWN (Feb 18 update)

Toppler Bowl March 22, 2026 (10 AM, 2 PM or **6 PM shifts**)

COST: \$120/team per shift (payable cash/cheque at the event)

- Best 3 of 4 game POA (2 player), team event
- Event **3 shifts available**: Bowlers can only enter one shift per registered/qualified Adult league.
- **Minimum of 12 teams/shift required: Max of 16 teams/ (10 AM & 2 PM shifts); Max of 32 teams/ (6 PM shift).**
- Teams are divided into two (2), three (3) or four (4) divisions, by random draw of teams participating in shift.
- Teams only complete within their assigned division

Event online entry deadline: March 13th, 2026, 11:59 PM

Additional Event Rules

- ❖ The entry fee is \$60.00/bowler (\$120/team) payable at the event. Cheques can be made payable to **CALGARY 5 PIN BOWLERS' ASSOCIATION** and cannot be postdated. NSF cheques will nullify entry.
- ❖ **All bowlers must be current members of the A5PBA and must be 18 years of age or older as of event date (March 22, 2026).**
- ❖ **Each Duo Team will consist of two (2) bowlers from the same Adult League in the Calgary Zone.**
- ❖ Entrants must use their highest average (**league or spare**) (**whichever is highest**) based on a **minimum of thirty-six (36) games** as of March 07, 2026, of the current bowling league season. **Tournament Statistician will verify bowlers' averages for each league at each centre involved. Bowlers will sign off on tournament average prior to start.**
- ❖ The lane draw will be conducted under the supervision of the Event Committee. There will be a maximum of four (4) bowlers (two Duo Teams) per lane per event.
- ❖ Any matters that arise during the event will be addressed and decided on at the event committee's discretion. All decisions will be final.
- ❖ C5PBA rules will be in effect unless otherwise specified.
- ❖ The use of electronic devices (i.e., iPods, mp3 players, cell phones, etc.) will not be permitted on the lanes.
- ❖ Calgary 5 Pin Bowlers' Association Neat and Tidy Dress Code will be followed.

Awards

- ❖ **At the conclusion of each shift, lineage certificates will be awarded to the top three (3) teams in each division.**
 - **First Place: 8 weeks per bowler (to maximum of 24 games each)**
 - **Second Place: 6 weeks per bowler (to maximum of 18 games each)**
 - **Third Place: 4 weeks per bowler (to maximum of 12 games each)**

Lineage Certificates are not transferable, have no cash value and are to be used for league lineage during the 2026-27 bowling season at any 5-pin bowling centre in the Calgary Zone (City of Calgary, Airdrie, Okotoks and Cochrane).
